## **Background**

Attached, please find Resolution No. 22-03, the Nature Foundation's 2023 Budget, presented as Exhibit A. This budget supports the projects, programs and initiatives outlined by the Board of Directors. As presented in Resolution No. 22-03, the total operating resources for 2023 are \$1,086,852 as follows:

The budget includes \$631,884 in expenditures. Of that, \$500,000, almost 80% is set aside to fulfill specific gift or grant agreements and fund the Forest Preserve's capital projects and programs. The remaining 20% or \$131,884 is funding for administration, the Foundation's core programs and events like the native plant sales, and its other fundraising functions.

The Foundation's largest growth areas have been in restricted and legacy gifts which are responsible for an over 300% growth in the budget from 2022 to 2023. Several new expenditures have been added to the budget including allocations for a 2022 audit, increased contingency, and increased contractual personnel costs and positions which will hopefully allow the Foundation to meet growing needs and interests.

As presented, the 2023 budget is showing a net loss in operating revenue of \$560,300 minus 2023 expenses of \$631,884 equals a net loss of \$71,584). However, over \$300,000 of the \$500,000 in capital project expenditures includes expenses associated with restricted gifts received in prior years that have carried over to 2023 since those projects have not been initiated and/or completed. Also included in the \$500,000 of capital projects is \$76,600 for the following Forest Preserve funding requests. \*Funds for these projects were awarded in 2022 and are either delayed or waiting a request for reimbursement. Total new requests are \$41,400. Approximately \$16,000 in funding for the Restore Will County Land Stewardship Grant program and the Serve Will County Youth Service Grant Program is also included in the capital project expenditures in restricted funds.
