**PLUGS:** Plugs require less digging and they establish quickly once planted. Many gardeners find it convenient to use a drill and auger to plant their plugs. Each plug is 5" deep and approximately 2.5" wide at the top.



**2.5x2.5 CONTAINERS:** Some of the more delicate plants like the spring ephemerals are grown in small containers that are 2.63" wide and 3.5" deep.



**PINT CONTAINERS:** Round containers that are approximately 4" wide and 4" deep.



**1GAL CONTAINERS:** Round containers that are approximately 5" wide and 6" deep.
